## Transfer Guide Covers Credits Earned from any Colorado Community College Prerequisites for Doctor of Pharmacy

The Doctor of Pharmacy program is 150 hours of full-time study, offered in nine semesters over four years. Prerequisite work must be completed prior to matriculation in the School of Pharmacy.

A minimum of 72 hours of prerequisite coursework is required prior to entry into the program.
